- 1 – 2" Pen + Gear binder with clear front pocket (found at Walmart) *labelled
- 1 – binder divider with 8 tabs (please put inside the binder)
- 7 – Duo Tang with metal fasteners, not pocket-style, NO PLASTIC please
 - 1 – Red
 - 1 – Yellow
 - 1 – Green
 - 1 – Dark Blue
 - 1 – Purple
 - 1 – Orange
 - 1 – Black
- 3 – 2 pocket folders – red, blue, green
- 1 – Hilroy exercise books ½ plain & ½ interlined, 72 pages (23.2 x 18.1 cm)
- 1 – Sketchbook, 9 x 12 inches, 30 pages *labelled
- 1 – Pack of post-it notes
- 1 – 20 count Crayola washable markers
- 1 – 60 count Crayola pre-sharpened pencil crayons

- 2 – Hilroy spiral notebook, 8 ½ x 10 (80 sheets)
