- 1 – 2" Pen + Gear binder with clear front pocket (found at Walmart) **\*labelled**
- 1 – binder divider with 8 tabs (please put inside the binder)
- 6 – Duo Tang with metal fasteners, not pocket-style, not plastic
  - 1 – Red (Math)
  - 1 – Yellow (Science)
  - 1 – Green (Social Studies)
  - 1 – Dark Blue (Language Arts)
  - 1 – Purple (Handwriting)
  - 1 – Orange (Reading)
- 1 – Hilroy exercise books ½ plain & ½ interlined, 72 pages ( 23.2 x 18.1 cm)
- 1 – Sketchbook, 9 x 12 inches, 30 pages **\*labelled**
