Dear Parents/Guardians,

On Wednesday, **January 12**, students in high school will be going to Mt. Seymour in North Vancouver (1700 Mt. Seymour Rd.) for a day in the snow. The students can choose to ski or snowboard. Students will be transported by VSTA bus. They will leave the school by 10:30 a.m. and will return between approximately 7:00 – 7:30 p.m., depending on Vancouver traffic. **The students will need to be picked up by parents or arrangements made to car pool with other students.**

Skiing and snowboarding are physically demanding sports and come with risk of injury. However, the school will take every possible precaution to ensure the safety of the students. We strongly encourage those students who have not skied/boarded very often to take lessons. Possible risks include, but are not limited to: traffic hazards, separation from group, unwanted approaches from strangers, motor vehicle accidents, or injuries from participating in the physical activities, etc.

Please make certain each student has appropriate clothing for a day spent in winter weather conditions. These include a warm winter jacket, waterproof pants/snow pants, hat, gloves, boots, warm socks (no ankle socks).

Cost: Skiing - \$49.00 (\$40 if you have your own equipment)
Snowboarding - \$49.00 (\$40 if you have your own equipment)

This year parents will register their child on-line with Mt Seymour, rather than with the school. At the time of registration, parents will complete the acknowledgement forms, pay with a credit card, and complete all information previously filled out on the First Tracks form, such as rentals equipment and medical information.
